Stylecare™ are specialist sanitised fabrics from SUNBURY DESIGN specifically for healthcare applications and for use in environments where an impervious, durable, stain resistant, 'safe fabric' is required.

Anti-microbial / Anti-fungal:	SILVERPLUS protection, fresh hygienic finish, no skin irritation, effective against 99.8% of micro-organisms including: clostridium difficile, listeria monocytogenes, escherichia coli, salmonella enteritidis, staphylococcus aureus (MRSA), pseudomonas aeruginosa, bacillus subtilis, salmonella typhimurium, streptococcus faecalis, legionella pneumophila, enterobacter aerogenes, altinata, aspergillus niger, cladosporium herbarism, penicillium.
Waterproof / Urea Resistant:	water or oil based solutions will not penetrate this fabric, PU waterproof film membrane meeting: BS 3424 part 26 hydrostatic head > 1 mtr. BS 3424 part 19 - no deterioration after 24 hour 5.5pH and 8.8pH Urea Soak.
Breathable:	BS 3546 water vapour permeability 65%.
Soil Resistant:	bionic finish, PFOS and PFOA free, excellent stain removal has been observed for; blood, urine, grease, ball point pen ink, betadine, ketchup, marmalade, mayonnaise, tea, mustard, coffee, iodine, suntan lotion (for best results always deal with stains immediately).
Flame Retardancy:	Upholstery, these fabrics are permanently FR meeting: BS EN 1021-1 : 1994 source 0 cigarette, BS EN 1021-2 : 1994 source 1 butane flame, BS 5852 : 1990 source CRIB 5, all tests over CMHR 35 foam. IMO upholstered furniture.
Martindale Abrasion:	in excess of 45 000 rubs, exceeds BS standard for Severe Contract Upholstery Use.
Light Fastness:	BS EN ISO 105 E02 1999 grade 4/5
Colour Fastness to Rubbing:	BS EN ISO 105: 1995 X12 grade 4/5 (wet and dry).
Tear Strength:	BS 4303 severe contract grade.
Burst Strength:	BS EN ISO 13978 severe contract grade.

Care and Cleaning:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. for routine cleaning mild soap & warm water sponging is effective, the best method is a 'wipe & dry' technique. Full immersion or soaking of the fabric is not recommended. 2. mild antiseptic cleaning agents can be used and more stubborn stains may require the use of a non ionic detergent (following manufacturers instructions). 3. for heavy soiling and infection control we recommend the use of a phenolic disinfectant solution or dilution of Dettol or similar (following manufacturers instructions). 4. for the most effective removal, all staining should be dealt with immediately. 5. <u>do not</u> dry clean, steam clean or use solvents as over time this could affect the performance of these fabrics. Due to the SILVERPLUS anti-microbial, anti-fungal and soil resistant treatments such cleaning practices should not be required. 6. Before any action we advise to check suitability of any cleaning method by applying to an area out of sight (or on a quality sample).
Colour Matching:	minor variations in colour and quality between production batches are possible. If an exact match is required please advise us at time of order and provide a cutting to match.
